World Energy GH2 – He stated a newspaper article misrepresented some of off takers that's going to be purchasing ammonia from different players in NL and NS. He clarified there are no delays with the project in Stephenville with World Energy.

The rally for World Energy was a success, with approximately 1500 people showing their support. This sent a strong message to World Energy and the government that the majority supports this project.

Councillor Aylward stated the hospital services will not be reduced, it has mammogram, dialysis, ultrasound technology, pain management, surgeons, and anesthesiologists. The clinic will offer different services, it will house physicians, nurse practitioners, diabetic nurses, and social workers. Mayor Rose responded, this clinic will replace the old aging buildings, Bay St. George Medical Clinic.
